

Water Levels (SLR) - Slipping Below 2 feet (above Chart Datum)

- For about 4 weeks, since July 20th, water levels have hovered around the 2 foot level.
- A return to dry conditions began to lower the level, then Tropical Storm Fred dumped a lot of rain into the southern half of the Lake Ontario Basin August 17-18.
- · We should see a small bump up from Fred, but the falling seasonal trend continues.
